When differently-abled can perform equally in education, we must ensure equity for them in terms of "Ease-of-Movement". Campuses around the country are not friendly for differently-abled. Poor investment in infrastructure and improper planning are leading causes of this menace.

Like every year, NSS IIT Delhi in association with Tryst is organizing Ideathon, a Social Innovation Challenge under the aegis of Kaizen'19. It will be a competition of innovative ideas (both Technological as well as Policy-related) on the topic '**Ease of living in campus for differently-abled**'. We invite both Undergraduate and Postgraduate students to present their ideas on the aforementioned topic. The best Ideas will be rewarded.

Problem Statement

Ease of Living in campus for differently abled

You are required to come up with a model/idea and present it, through which this problem can be solved. The idea/model can be either **Technological** or **Policy-based**. Note that your idea/model should enable the differently-abled people to utilize most of the facilities or infrastructure within the campus and should focus on their independence in movement.

Event Structure

Round 1 :

Online Submission in the form of a Presentation/PDF of a maximum of 8 slides (which includes a slide on team introduction). This presentation will be used for shortlisting teams for the On-Campus Round 2.

While shortlisting, the following things will be kept in mind:

1. Address the problems related to disability.
2. Practicality and Creativity of the solution provided by the team.
3. Analytical skills shown by the team in answering the question: "How impactful, the solution is?"

The shortlisted teams will be invited for On-Campus round and will be given the opportunity to present their model to a panel of eminent judges. The exact details of the format will be sent to the shortlisted teams.

Rule Book

- Each team will be given 6 minutes for the presentation followed by a 3 minutes Q&A session.
- Each team shall comprise of 1-6 members.
- Though inter-college team isn't allowed but undergraduates and graduates with valid ID cards are free to come together to form a single team.
- The decision of organising team will be final and binding. The organising team has every right to disqualify a team based on interrupting in conducting the event smoothly, with rightful justification.
- All teams making it to the on-campus round will be eligible to get a Certificate of Participation.
- NSS IITD and Tryst will not bear any cost related to travel of the participants.

Prizes and Certificates

Certificate of Participation will be given to all legal entries.

Certificate of Excellence to top 3 teams along with prizes worth 20k.
